### **Tees Valley Warm Homes Fund**

Stockton Borough Council are leading on this on behalf of us and the other councils in the Tees Valley to install central heating where there isn't currently any. ### **Warm Up Hartlepool**

The Council is working with a number of companies who have funding available for replacement of old/inefficient gas boilers and insulation. There are many ways to be eligible for this funding and this can be found on the Council's website:

Once registered, a survey will be booked and the assessor will explain everything, including the process, timescale, what work is eligible and whether they will have a contribution to pay.
